



Funding conditions of the Open Access Publication Fund-for monographs and miscellanies of the University Library of Siegen

- Eligible for funding are so far unpublished monographs and miscellanies which are accessible free of charge and immediately upon their publication on the internet (open access monographs and miscellanies) and that apply a system of quality control commonly accepted in the particular subject before publication (e.g. peer review, or other review processes, editorial board, scientific editorial report).
- The publisher is listed in the <u>Directory of Open Access Books</u> (DOAB) and / or is a member of the <u>Open Access Scholarly Publishers Association</u> (OASPA).
- The applicant is member of the University of Siegen (cf. §9 <u>HG NRW</u>) and is as author of the monograph or editor of the miscellany responsible for the financing of the publication.
- The affiliation to the University of Siegen of the author or the editor must be clearly stated within the publication.
- The use of an ORCID-ID (and its inclusion in the application form) is highly recommended.
- A persistent identifier has been assigned to the publication, e.g. <u>DOI</u> or <u>URN</u>.
- It is highly recommended to apply a Creative Commons licence (preferably CC-BY).
- The funding through the publication fund of the University of Siegen should be indicated within the publication.
- Funding is only possible if the costs for the publication are not fully covered by project grants or other financial means. Overpaid or erroneously paid funding can be reclaimed.
- Funding is granted for publication fees up to a maximum amount of 3.000,- €. The combination with other funding for the publication is possible, if the other funding does not cover the total costs.
- Only open access publication fees are eligible for funding, charges for printing, setting, additional colour or page charges etc. are not eligible. The publication fees are described in a comprehensible calculation by the publisher.
- The publication charges first have to be paid to the publisher by the author or the editor or the institute from own funds of the university institute. Upon request, the charges are reimbursed through the open access publication fund up to the granted amount of funding.
- Funding through the Open Access Publication Funds for monographs and miscellanies is only possible for one publication per person and year.
- Applications can be submitted up to 6 months after the invoice has been issued.
- The funded publication is made publicly available online without restrictions on the open access repository OPUS Siegen by the author or the editor. The publication of further, subject-based repositories is welcome.
- Applications for grants are dealt with in order of receipt. Funding can only be distributed up to the total of the publication fund. If these financial means are exhausted further funding is not possible.
- The decision on funding as such and the level of funding is up to the University Library.
