



Funding conditions of the Open Access Publication Fund for journal articles of the University Library of Siegen

- Eligible are articles in journals which consists only of contributions which are accessible free of charge and immediately upon their publication on the internet (pure, gold open access) and that strictly apply a system of quality control (e.g. peer review) commonly accepted in the particular subject.
- The journal is listed in the <u>Directory of Open Access Journals</u> (DOAJ) and /or the publisher is a member of the <u>Open Access Scholarly Publishing Association</u> (OASPA).
- The open activation of articles in subscription journals according to the "hybrid "model, such as "Hogrefe Open Mind", "Oxford Open" or "SAGE Choice", is not eligible for funding.
- The applicant is member of the University of Siegen (cf. §9 HG NRW) and is as "submitting author" or "corresponding author" responsible for the payment of publication fees.
- The affiliation of the author to the University of Siegen must be clearly stated. An official e-mail address of the "submitting author "or "corresponding author" is used as contact address in the article (e.g. "Surname.Name@uni-siegen.de").
- The use of an ORCID-ID (and its inclusion in the application data/form) is highly recommended.
- A persistent identifier is assigned to the publication, e.g. DOI or URN.
- The use of a <u>creative commons license</u> (preferably CC-BY) is highly recommended.
- The funding through the publication fund of the University of Siegen should be indicated within the publication.
- Funding is only possible if the costs for the publication are not fully covered by project grants or other financial means. Overpaid or erroneously paid funding can be reclaimed.
- Funding is possible for publication fees up to a maximum of 2.000,- € (including VAT). In the case of higher publication fees a partial grant of 2000, € is possible.
- Only article processing charges (APCs) are eligible for funding, other publication fees e.g. handling/submission fees, fees for figures, color charges or other fees are not eligible.
- The publication charges first have to be paid to the publisher by the "submitting author" or "corresponding author" or the respective institute from own funds of the university institute. Request the charges are reimbursed through the open access publication fund up to the granted amount of funding.
- Applications can be submitted up to 6 months after the invoice has been issued.
- The funded publication is made publicly available online without restrictions on the open access repository OPUS Siegen by the author. The publication of further, subject-based repositories is welcome.
- Applications for grants are dealt with in order of receipt. Funding can only be distributed until the financial means of the publication fund are exhausted.
- The decision on funding as such and the level of funding up to the University Library.
